2025 MD-04 YEAR IN REVIEW

FIGHTING FOR YOU

This year, I fought to protect more than 46,000 federal workers in MD 04 from layoffs, attacks on collective bargaining, and harmful executive actions, while advancing legislation to strengthen the civil service. I defended critical institutions like BARC and NASA Goddard so they can continue their essential work. I also stood for fairness and due process in our immigration system, securing a meaningful victory for families and the rule of law. I remain committed to serving Maryland's Fourth District with integrity and determination.



REAL RESULTS

When you need help navigating a federal agency, I am here to advocate for you. This year, my office responded to 51,450 letters, assisted 2,178 residents through casework, attended 362 community events and hosted 16 community events connecting with 22,429 constituents. I have delivered real results by securing more than \$15 million in Community Project Funding, including \$3 million for the Beltsville Agriculture Research Center. Through casework, we returned over \$11 million to residents and supported projects that brought \$155 million in new federal investments to our district.



CELEBRATING MD-04'S BEST

Supporting young people in our district is a top priority. My office proudly participates in the Congressional Art Competition and the Congressional App Challenge, showcasing the creativity of MD 04 students. Congratulations to winners Ibukun Akinterinwa of Charles H. Flowers High School and Aashi Moola of Eleanor Roosevelt High School. I also provide Service Academy nominations and support student leadership through our Youth Advisory Board. This year, my office issued 1,013 Congressional commendations and assists with Capitol tours and tickets.
